1. Collections & Access Rights –

- 1.1. We can tweak this ourselves.
- 1.2. Basically this is a security issue.
- 1.3. Define both search and contribute policies. North Carolina has defined only 3 collections - Higher Ed, K12, and statewide. There are no other separate collections.
- 1.4. The incident we had prior to the April SCORE training was a corrupted index, not a security issue. Re-indexing fixed that.

2. Copyright/Digital Rights Tweaking –

We can do this ourselves once the policy is in place.

3. "Resource Type" changed to "Format" throughout the system –

Betsy has fixed this.

4. Detailed display edits –

- 4.1. We might need TLE for this as it requires the skill of XSMML.
- 4.2. We need to define the requirements for displays first – brief, full, user, Administrator...

5. "Unnamed package" for downloaded Wisconsin learning objects –

Peter has a fix for this.

6. Assembler –

- 6.1. Is this what we need training for?
- 6.2. This might require Java skill.

7. Federation –

- 7.1. Georgia – We are still retrieving Los that are restricted to Georgia via federation.
- 7.2. Florida – Not consistent; it works sometimes.
- 7.3. We need to define our requirements for federation and get best practices.

8. Building blocks –

- 8.1. What are the best practices?
- 8.2. How are we going to manage duplicate accounts generated from the interfaces?
Check with Cathy of Florida on this.
- 8.3. Using Shibboleth will sync up accounts.
- 8.4. We can elect to use unique prefix to help with identical UIDs.
